MS CHAMPS Wins National Award

Mississippi CHAMPS won its third consecutive national award for reducing racial disparities in breastfeeding. MS CHAMPS stands for Communities and Hospitals Advancing Maternity Practices and is a program of CHEER. The Office of Women's Health launched the Reducing Disparities in Breastfeeding Innovation Challenge Award to reward programs for increasing breastfeeding rates, decreasing disparities, and successfully growing. MS CHAMPS won Phase 1 in 2021. In 2023. MS CHAMPS was awarded Phase 2. Now, MS CHAMPS has won all three challenges and has been awarded \$100,000. Director of the CHAMPS program, Anne Merewood, PhD announced, "We're really proud of this achievement, and most of all, what it means for the mothers and babies of Mississippi." The average rate of breastfeeding initiation at hospitals enrolled in the program has increased from 56% in 2015 to 69% in 2023. The average rate of exclusive breastfeeding has increased from 26% to 40%. For Black mother-infant dyads, the rate of breastfeeding initiation increased from 42% in 2015 to 57% in 2023. The rate of breastfeeding exclusively increased 16% for Black-mother-infant dyads from 14% to 30%. Each month, the gap in breastfeeding initiation between Black and white mother-infant dyads lessened by 0.05%. After MS CHAMPS began its involvement in Mississippi, the number of Baby-Friendly® designated hospitals increased from 0 to 29 and now over 75% of the state's birth takes place in Baby-Friendly® hospitals. In September 2023, The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention entered a \$6,000 cooperative agreement with CHAMPS to expand the program nationwide and enroll 100 hospitals.
