## Sisters in Birth, Inc.

Sisters in Birth, Inc. is a nonprofit case management pregnancy center funded by the Kellogg Foundation. The organization provides comprehensive services that increase prenatal and postpartum visits, improve the patient's overall pregnancy experience, and increase rates of full-term, vaginal births and breastfeeding. Founder and Executive Director Getty Isreal created the organization, "because there was a time when I was a single mother without a support group." The center is located in Jackson's medical district and is open to girls and women ages 14 to 30. Services provided include: free pregnancy testing, home health screenings, childbirth education classes, breastfeeding support, physician referrals, prenatal nutrition education, instructor-led yoga classes, doula-supported births, after-birth support, and discounted SmartyPants prenatal vitamins. Young women who complete the program will receive a free crib and car seat. Those that have full-term vaginal deliveries and who breastfeed will receive a financial incentive.
